5. Himalayan balsam (*Impatiens glandulifera*)
6. Parrot feather (*Myriophyllum aquaticum*)
7. Yellow Floating Heart (*Nymphoides peltata*)
8. European frog-bit (*Hydrocharis morsus-ranae*)
9. European Water-clover (*Marsilea quadrifolia*)
10. Water chestnut (*Trapa natans*)
11. Asian carps (also on the National List)
